Five Myths about the 2024 CPA Exam



Myth #1: I must pass core sections first.

False. You can take the exams in any order, but Surgent recommends taking the discipline that corresponds to a given core immediately after the core for that discipline.

- FAR > BAR
- AUD > ISC
- REG > TCP



Myth #2: I can only take a discipline exam once.

False. If you fail a discipline exam, you can try the same discipline again or switch to another discipline at any time.



Myth #3: I must take a discipline section that matches my career or job.

False. You don't have to take a discipline section that matches your career or job. Take which one you are most likely to pass. This will likely be BAR, since it most closely matches college curricula.



Myth #4: If I pass an exam section now, I will have to retake it after Jan. 1, 2024.

False. Any exam section you have credit for on Jan. 1, 2024 will still count toward licensure. Plus, you will get an extended 18-month window for all previously passed parts on that date!



Myth #5: BEC content is completely going away.

False. BEC content will be split among four of the six exam sections. The section is gone, but the content remains.
